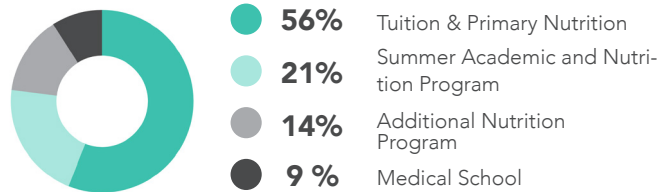
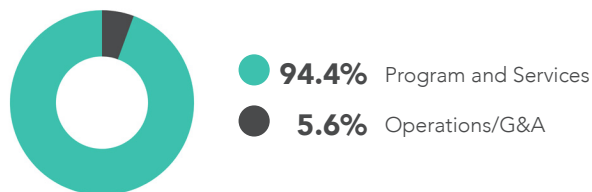

A WORD FROM OUR FOUNDER



The 2021-2022 school year was met with unprecedented challenges but with the support of our generous donors Nourish Every Child (NEC) was able to persevere. While grappling with the global pandemic, Haiti was thrust into further economic and political instability when their President, Jovenel Moise,

was assassinated on July 7th, 2021. The resultant political instability led to increased violence and unprecedented levels of insecurity. Haiti remains the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere and one of the poorest countries in the Western Hemisphere. The political unrest and dire economic crisis have pushed an additional 200,000 children into hunger, with a staggering 2.4 million Haitian children experiencing malnutrition.

We have never been more dedicated to our mission and with your support we are making a difference in the lives of some of Haiti's most vulnerable children. We believe in our program model and are proud to share our 2021 Annual Impact Report. The report highlights the continued impact Nourish Every Child is having addressing the emotional, nutritional, and educational needs of these children.

One key element of our program is the concept of family unification to combat the Haitian orphan crisis. Whenever it is possible, we believe it is in the best interest of a child to be raised in a home with love. The support Nourish Every Child provides keeps countless children from languishing in

Haitian orphanages. We have witnessed time and time again, children in our program whose family members were faced with the impossible decision of relinquishing their children to an orphanage to save their lives from malnutrition. The nutritional and educational support NEC provides allows these children to stay with their families and THRIVE!

We are proud to share one such story. Listo Mathieu Jean Louis was referred to NEC when he was just ten years old. He was raised by his mother who struggled to provide for her two sons, as she made less than \$2 per day. Listo was chronically malnourished and unable to attend school. After years of nutritional and educational support from NEC, Listo completed high school in 2021 and was admitted to Haitian medical school! Listo is the recipient of the first ever Nourish Every Child medical school scholarship and looks forward to returning to his community and paying it forward. This is how the cycle of poverty is broken, one child at a time.

With your continued support, we will work tirelessly with the people of Haiti to break the cycle of poverty. In return for your support, we offer you commitment, transparency, and results.
